### What? Key Knowledge Takeaways

#### Knowledge:

Understand natural and man-made materials.  
 Understand terms such as tone, texture and collage.

 The climate, habitats and animals of Antarctica.

#### Skills:

Use a range of natural and man-made materials to create collages.  
 Mix a range of colours, shades and tones and match colours to objects.  
 Experiment with painting techniques, adding texture to paint.  
 Order sounds to create a beginning, middle and end in a composition.  
 Control playing instruments so that they sound as they should.  
 Perform dances using simple movements.

### Key Vocabulary

### Definition

#### Tone

The lightness or darkness of an image (eg: shade).

#### Texture

Perceived surface quality of art with 2d and 3d properties.

#### Collage

Pasting various materials on to a single surface to create a new effect or image.

#### Pitch

How high or low a sound is depending the frequency.

#### Tempo

How fast or slow the music is (pace).

#### Mood

The feeling created by a piece of music. This could be dependent on the instruments, pitch, tempo and volume.
