

<u>Art</u>

Georges-Pierre Seurat was a French post-Impressionist artist. He is best known for devising the painting techniques known as pointillism. He was born in 1851 and died in 1891.

Music

Key Vocabulary	Definition
hatching	Shading with closely drawn parallel lines.
tone	Each distinguishable shade variation from black to white on imagery.
Pointillism	An approach to painting that is associated with a soft flickering of dots or strikes of colour.
unison	To perform a movement at the same time.
cannon	To perform the same movement in turn.
crescendo	A piece of music gradually becoming louder.
accelerando	The speed at which music is or ought to be played.
coda	A word for the ending of a piece of music.
