## Definition

<b>hatching</b>	Shading with closely drawn parallel lines.
<b>tone</b>	Each distinguishable shade variation from black to white on imagery.
<b>Pointillism</b>	An approach to painting that is associated with a soft flickering of dots or strikes of colour.
<b>unison</b>	To perform a movement at the same time.
<b>cannon</b>	To perform the same movement in turn.
<b>crescendo</b>	A piece of music gradually becoming louder.
<b>accelerando</b>	The speed at which music is or ought to be played.
<b>coda</b>	A word for the ending of a piece of music.
