## Year 1

We've had a lovely final week of the term in Year 1. We came to the end of our Art theme, finishing with a burst of colour as we recreated our own Eric Carle inspired collages. The children began the week exploring texture through paint. They used a variety of interesting 'tools' to create textures on their painted sheets, including painting with scrunched up tissue paper, using forks to create lines and bubble wrap. They then used stencils to cut different pieces from their painted sheets to create their very own Eric Carle minibeast. Their final pieces looked fantastic!

This week we were also treated to a special musical

performance of Jack and the Beanstalk. We loved getting involved and had a great time. Finally, a huge well done to all the children in Year 1 who have worked so hard this term. We wish you a happy Easter and Ramadan.



### <u>Year 2</u>

We have had a very creative final week of the term in Year 2. The children have been producing their final pieces of artwork for our 'Ice' theme. Having explored a range of techniques and art mediums over the past 4 weeks, they have then combined all of these in our final pieces of artwork. All of the children have had so much fun trying to include paint, collage and charcoals in their work. We are very proud of the work we have created! ### Year 3

Our Spring Term came to a creative close this week with the completion of our sea turtle paintings.

We chose to look at a range of sea turtle paintings by lots of different artists as we enjoyed learning about the endangered turtles in our Grand Designs lessons last half term. Some of the children made them too.

The children used their colour mixing skills from last week to produce the ocean colours needed. The



background was painted first with a lot of care taken. They mixed blue with yellow to make green and added a little red to blue to make purple. They found adding white made the colours lighter and black made the tone darker. As they painted the children listened to relaxing music with the ocean as the theme.

Today the children are adding the sea turtles to their background. We are hoping to display some of them by Mrs Simpson's office and some in our Year Three Art Gallery (our cloakroom!).

At lunch times if your child requires some quiet time then they are welcome to sit quietly in the library to read a book or to use their ipads.

If they would like to perform the dhur prayer then they can use the spare 4A classroom next to the staff room which will be supervised.

Finally we wish all of our Muslim pupils and Community a Blessed and Happy Ramadan.
