## What's been happening in school this week?

#### **Nursery**

We have had a super first week back in Nursery. On Tuesday we had a visit from Dudley family learning who shared the story 'Dear Zoo' with us. We then had the opportunity to complete some creative activities to extend the children's learning. The children thoroughly enjoyed making their masks, snakes and stick puppets. ### Reception

The children have come back ready for learning in reception and have enjoyed exploring their celebration provision. They have listened well and learnt new words for their new whole class reading book and new sounds in phonics.

They have also been very respectful and compassionate this week when making poppies for Remembrance Day.

### Year 1

We've had a great first week back in Year 1. We kickstarted our week looking at what makes us different and unique as part of our British Value focus on Mutual Respect. The children drew pictures of each other and wrote sentences on how different we all are.

The children also learnt about Remembrance Day and created their own fields of poppies using their fingers to create textured paintings.

We also began our new English unit based on the brilliant story The Snail and the Whale. The children have begun to put a postcard



together using ambitious vocabulary, and they've really enjoyed seeing their wonderful sentences on display.

#### Year 2

Welcome back! Year 2 have had a brilliant first week back following the half term break. It was lovely to see the children's enthusiasm when they came into school on Monday, and this positivity has continued all week. We had a great start, where we were exploring the British Value of

Mutual Respect. We thought about how we were similar and different to each other and how that is important. We also discussed different ways we can show respect in school, at home and to others.

The children have also been learning about Remembrance Day and the meaning behind the poppy.

We also began our new Geography theme this week. We discussed maps and why

they were useful. We then went for a walk around Colley Lane, where we thought about the symbols we could use to represent different features on our maps. Next Friday we will be going for a walk around our local area, where we will complete a survey of things such as cars, vehicles and buildings.

Welcome back. We have made respect, mutual tolerance and compassion the focus this week.

The children found out about Remembrance day and why we buy

poppies every year. Can they tell you why some of their poppies are purple?

The children also wrote some beautiful Acrostic poems thinking about respect, kindness, differences between us all and friendship.

Have a lovely weekend everyone and see you next week.


#### <u>Year 4</u>
