<u>Year 1</u>

We have had a fantastic week in Year 1 packed full of wonderful learning.

Our highlight this week was launching our new Historical Detectives theme by looking at baby photographs! The children loved trying to match the baby pictures to Colley Lane staff and looking at pictures of themselves

In other learning this week, we explored number bonds within 10 in Maths and in English we practised writing capital letters, adding spaces after each word and finishing our sentences with a full stop! Well done Year 1 on a brilliant week!

This week children have started to access different areas of the classroom using a band system to help them choose where they would like to play. The children have shown real resilience staying in their chosen classroom and developing their play.

They have been creating pictures of their family and beginning to use letters and words to communicate their ideas.
