What's been happening in school this week?

Nursery

This week the children have started to learn all about 2D shapes. We have been looking at circles and triangles. They have been introduced to key vocabulary such as sides and corners and we even went on a 2D shape hunt around Nursery looking for circles and triangles.





This week we have also been practising our makaton for our Christmas song. The children are all trying really hard to join in with the words and actions. I will be sharing the video on ClassDojo so that you can share it with your child at home if you wish.

Reception

This week the children have thoroughly enjoyed their DT skills lessons linked to making a sandwich. The children worked hard to follow instructions to make their sandwich and enjoyed eating them! They also listened well during our hand washing talk from our school nurse and learnt about the importance of washing hands.





<u>Year 1</u>

We've had another great week in Year 1. The children really enjoyed exploring maps as part of our new Geography theme. We explored Google Earth by searching for our school and the children were excited to spot some of their favourite

features but not many physical ones. We did a tally to count how many of each human feature we saw.

places - the Reception playground and the strip where they enjoy playing in our afternoon break! We looked at different maps and identified various symbols before the children drew their own maps detailing their journey from home to school. They even added symbols to their maps, including a book to show our local library and a knife and fork for McDonalds!

In our computer lessons we have been learning about algorithms. We have programmed various 'sprites' to move around



the screen stopping off at different points. They have been mastering the basic way to use directional language and debugging their algorithms if they went wrong. The children have really loved learning how to do this.

We use ipads across the week to support, explore and extend learning. The ipads were used in Maths here for working on column subtraction.

The children predicted what the book might be about and whether they thought they would enjoy it - it seems to have captured their imagination!

We've had a creative week in Year 4. This has included creating a golden ticket as part of our writing experience day linked to Charlie and The Chocolate Factory. Next week, children will be writing the next section of the story. We will be looking forward to reading their work.

Children have created decorations and started some prep work ahead of the fast approaching Christmas season. Exciting!
