# **Nursery**

# Reception



Autumn has arrived in reception! Children have enjoyed exploring different autumnal objects this week. They have developed their fine motor skills threading beads onto sticks, mark making with sticks and making autumn scenes with playdoh, conkers, leaves and acorns.

As part of their whole class reading work, they also tasted different breads and even had a go at making their own bread today. I wonder what story book they are going to read next week.

## Year 1

It's been a week of fun practical learning in Year 1. We really enjoyed exploring the human body in Science this week with the children

This week has brought us to the end of our Sentence Stacking writing around 'The star in the jar'. The children have been using adjectives to build intensity and onomatopoeias to describe. Next week the children will be independently writing their 'Star in the jar' story and hopefully showcasing the skills and new vocabulary we have been working on together.

# Year 5

This week has been crammed full with lots of lovely activities! We really haven't stopped!

In Theme, we learnt about the Ancient Gods of Greece, including Zeus, Poseidon and Hades. We learnt about their roles in mythology and how they were seen by the people of Greece. We also began to look at life for the Ancient Greek people. We looked at their homes and their daily lives in towns and cities.


