Schools in the Windsor Academy Trust family are absolutely committed to doing all we can to make pupils feel safe from bullying in school.

Each school has a contextualised approach to bullying that meets the needs of pupils in the school. Our school level approaches have the following key factors in common:

- being clear as a community on what we mean by bullying
- teaching pupils what bullying is
- making it easy to report bullying
- creating a culture where bullying can be confidently reported
- making it clear to everyone that we take bullying seriously
- dealing with bullying through our behaviour policy, and, where appropriate, the exclusions and suspensions policy.

At the trust level, we monitor bullying incidents through our annual safeguarding audits and 'summits'. Where we find problems with bullying, these are made a priority in our school-level action plans.

Through our schools having their own contextual approaches to bullying, aligned with the key factors above, monitored through safeguarding audits and 'summits', with any issues addressed through school-level action planning, we aim to create environments where pupils feel safe and confident, and where bullying is addressed effectively.
