Curriculum

Colley Lane Academy will:

Working at Home

Colley Lane Academy will:

- Read frequently with their children and support Accelerated Reader in Key Stage 2
- Support children in their home learning
- Help children to find a quiet place to do their reading/homework
- Ensure children look after school

Attendance & Punctuality

Colley Lane Academy will:

- Contact parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance or lateness
- Maintain an accurate record of attendance
- Start classes promptly in line with each Key Stage
- Not authorise holiday absence during term time unless under exceptional circumstances

Parents/Carers will:

- Make sure children attend regularly and arrive on time
- Collect children on time at the end of the school day
- Contact school as soon as possible when children are absent
- Not take holidays during term time unless pre authorised by the school
