<p><b>National Tutoring Programme in Year 5</b> In the summer term, a fully qualified teacher tutor is working directly with children in year 5 to help turbo boost our children’s learning in Maths and Reading comprehension skills.</p>	
<p><b>Accelerated Learning - Powered by Digital Technology</b> This has included investing in: Google Enterprise Education G-Suite, staff devices, student devices, staff training, content development, safety software and a range of equipment. The focus has been to accelerate learning of core Maths and English skills in lessons in a way that complements Quality First Teaching.</p>	
<p><b>Subscription to Learning Village</b> Online EAL and SEND resource targeted at supporting the development of core language skills in children with special educational needs and who have English as an additional language.</p>	
<p><b>Phonic Boosters</b> Additional phonic sessions for EYFS/ KS1 and Y3 delivered by phonically trained teachers and TAs.</p>	

**Summer School Provision**

Out of term time provision for children to participate in a combination of core Maths and English related accelerated learning and broader enrichment activities.

**Talk Time**

Trained HLTA provides ongoing support to children who have experienced social and emotional disruption.
